As you may know, we're reforming our justice system. It's an ambitious £1bn programme that will, by 2022, have made far-reaching changes for those who use the system and for those who work within it.

We at HMCTS need to do more to engage and to listen to the wider legal professional community. I want to ensure we are hearing your ideas and proposals directly on a number of key issues, including court listing, better use of telephone and video technology and flexible operating hours.
